I agree to provide my own medical insurance coverage to supplement the coverage provided by the Church and agree to work with the Church to properly execute any claims that may arise. Prior to trip departure, I agree to provide a copy of my family's health insurance ID card to the trip leader.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY: The cost of the trip is \$1,500, payable to First Presbyterian Church. I agree to pay 1/2 of the trip cost (less the \$150 deposit) by Nov. 1, 2007, and the balance by March 1, 2008. Since the cost of this trip includes an amount for a free-day activity, I understand that only the mission-service portion of the trip charges (\$1,475) will be considered a contribution to First Presbyterian Church.
